Year of Jubilee Leviticus 25:8-54 July 28, 2024

Sermon Points:

- 1. "Consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you; each of you is to return to your family property and to your own clan." (Expert from Leviticus 25:8-17)
- 2. Jesus came not to destroy the Law, but to Fulfill the Law
 - A. Matthew 5:17
- 3. Sabbath Year.
 - A. The Sabbath year was to be every 7th year. No one will work or farm the land.
 - B. Every 50th year was to be the Year of Jubilee when All leased or mortgaged lands would be returned, and slaves would be set free.
- 4. The 3 implications of The Year of Jubilee.
 - A. Theological:
 - God is the true owner of all of Israel's land.
 - Israel's observance of Sabbath and of the Jubilee, is a practice of obedience and trust
 - B. Social:
 - Future generations would not have to bear The burdens of their distant ancestors.
 - C. Economic:
 - The Year of Jubilee was not about redistribution but Restoration.
- 5. Our own forgiveness is linked to our willingness to forgive others.
