Small group discussion questions

Reality #2 - God pursues you to have a love relationship with you, one that is real and personal.

1. When Philip heard from God he knew immediately what it was that God was calling him to do. Sometime we want to say “let me pray about that”. While it is wise to pray about things are there times we need to move forward in obedience with what God has called us to do? What are the dangers of delayed disobedience?
2. Philip was asked to go out into the desert at midday not knowing what was waiting for him. Talk about an occasion when by faith you followed what God was asking you to do not knowing what it was that God had in store for you.
3. “Do you understand what you are reading?” This probing question resulted in a God conversation. What other probing questions might you have asked if you were in Philips place? Do you find it hard to listen to what people say? Do you find yourself waiting for an opening to show the person what you know? If you struggle in listening rather than showing people what you know why not ask the group members to pray for you about this?
4. The Eunuch went away rejoicing over what God had done in his life. What difference has God made in your life? Do you find yourself rejoicing over the things God has done or do you find yourself taking them for granted?
