 - A. We may not know the answer entirely (1 Corinthians 2:11).
- 4. When we pray "Your Kingdom Come", we are saying: Bring your Kingdom into being.
 - A. We want God's plans and purposes, God's agenda to come into fruition.
- 5. Whose Kingdom are you working towards?
 - A. Idolatry is turning a good thing into an ultimate thing.
- 6. Decide now to pursue God's Kingdom.
