Sermon Points:

- 1. Phileos φίλος Friendship, brotherhood.
 - Social capital a concept used in sociology and economics to define networks of relationships which are productive towards advancing the goals of individuals and groups.
 - Without Social Capital, people become increasingly isolated and more prone to extremist positions and ideologies.
- 2. The world needs Love that has backbone, substance, and purpose.
 - "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:13-17).
 - Jesus gave his life for you and I: His Friends.
 - Jesus has chosen us to go and bear fruit.
 - "Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves." (Romans 12:10).
 - "Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters." (Hebrew 13:1).
