Sermon Points:

- 1. The ministry of John the Baptist – sent to prepare the way of the Lord (Mark 1:1-4).**
 - The period of “400 silent years” was over. The Messiah was coming as prophesied by Isaiah 800 years ago.
- 2. The baptism of Jesus – introducing Jesus to Israel as the Lamb of God (Mark 1:9-11).**
 - As John’s ministry began to decline, Jesus’ was just beginning.
- 3. The temptation of Jesus – preparing Him to face the difficult tasks ahead (Mark 1:12-13).**
 - Jesus can understand our temptations and provides us comfort and aid.

 - Capernaum.
 - The synagogue of Sabbath day.
- 7. The Manner of Jesus’ Teaching Mark 1:22.**
 - “No one ever spoke the way this man does” (John 7:46).
 - Jesus did signs (miracles) that proved his authority.
 - Jesus claims all authority in heaven and on earth (Matthew 28).
