Lent: Jesus Way Maker Miracle Worker "Jesus' Power Over Nature" Mark 4:35-41 March 23, 2025

Sermon Points:

1. Jesus Calms the Storm.

- Jesus resting during the storm was indicative of his trust in God's plans.
- The disciples cried for Jesus' help feeling they were abandoned.
- As Jesus got up, he rebuked the wind and waves commanding them: "Peace! Be still!".
- Jesus turns to his disciples and says: "Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?"
- 2. Faith is not the absence of fear; it's the presence of trust in God's sovereignty.
 - 1. Acknowledge the storms that we're in right now.
 - 2. Ask for help.
 - 3. Let's keep our eyes on him.
 - 4. Look back.
- 3. Life will bring storms, but we are not alone. Jesus is in the boat with us, ready to calm the winds and bring peace.
