

Lent: Jesus Way Maker Miracle Worker
“Jesus’ Power Over Nature”
Mark 4:35-41
March 23, 2025

Sermon Points:

1. Jesus Calms the Storm.

- Jesus resting during the storm was indicative of his trust in God’s plans.
- The disciples cried for Jesus’ help feeling they were abandoned.
- As Jesus got up, he rebuked the wind and waves commanding them: “Peace! Be still!”.
- Jesus turns to his disciples and says: “Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?”

2. Faith is not the absence of fear; it’s the presence of trust in God’s sovereignty.

1. Acknowledge the storms that we’re in right now.
2. Ask for help.
3. Let’s keep our eyes on him.
4. Look back.

3. Life will bring storms, but we are not alone. Jesus is in the boat with us, ready to calm the winds and bring peace.
